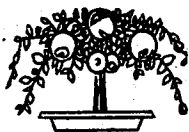


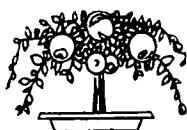

## PROCEEDINGS

### FIRST SITTING—Wednesday, July 15, 1942.

The Sixth Annual Conference of the Central District of the Pilgrim Holiness Church convened at 9:30 A. M. at 2117 Market Street, Hannibal, Missouri. Rev. D. W. Bunting led the Conference in singing the following hymns: "He Abides"—"He's Coming Back"—"Lily of the Valley."

Rev. Friend Glendenning, pastor of the P. H. Church of Marshall, Ill., led in prayer. The Conference joined in singing, "He Brought me Out."

Rev. W. O. Bottenberg, District Superintendent, introduced Rev. L. W. Sturk, second Assistant General Superintendent of Cincinnati, Ohio, the presiding officer of the Conference. Bro. Sturk read Matt. 4: 18-22; and addressed the Conference on the theme, "Fishers of Men." His message was both edifying and inspiring.

Rev. R. A. Beltz was asked to assist the Secretary and take the minutes of this sitting as the Secretary had to be excused to conduct a radio program.

The roll of ordained and licensed ministers, deaconesses and church delegates was called.

Moved and seconded that the first five rows of seats on either side and the platform constitute the Conference bar. Carried.

Moved and seconded that the time of meetings be 9:00 to 11:30 of mornings only. Carried.

### **SECOND SITTING—Thursday, July 16, 1942**

The Conference was opened at 9 A. M. by singing song, "I'll Live for Thee," led by Edward Boone. Prayer by Rev. R. W. Wolfe, secretary of General Home Missions. The Conference joined in singing another song, "Jesus Saves."

Brother Wolfe was introduced to the Conference and gave greetings.

Brother S. I. Emery spoke a few words of testimony and greetings.

Mrs. E. W. Stuart of Des Moines, Iowa, sang a special song, entitled, "Alone with God."

Rev. L. W. Sturk led the Devotions with Scripture reading from Psalms 84, giving comments upon the same.

Roll call was called for by the Chairman and was given by the Secretary.

Report of the examining and educational board was called for and was read and accepted.

The time for the election of officers was set for 10 A. M. Friday.

Announcements were made by the District Superintendent.

Adjournment by expiration of time.

Brother S. I. Emery dismissed with prayer.

### **THIRD SITTING—Friday, July 17, 1942**

The Conference opened at 9 A. M. with a stirring song service, and prayer by Rev. M. L. Peterson of Omaha, Neb.

The devotions were led by Rev. L. W. Sturk, speaking to the preachers from the 14th chapter of Romans on "Practical Points for Pilgrims."

The minutes of the last sitting were read and approved.

The order of the hour was the election of District officers. The following being elected:

Those elected on the examining and educational board were as follows:

Rev. H. H. Bolender, Rev. W. Lloyd Smith, 3 years; Rev. Edward Boone, Mrs. H. H. Bolender, 2 years; Rev. A. I. Wise, 1 year.

The Conference by acclamation of vote elected the District Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent, Secretary and Treasurer as the District Trustees.

Brother O. E. Fields from Council Bluff, Iowa, sang by request, "Homecoming Week."

Adjourned by expiration of time.

#### **FOURTH SITTING—Saturday, July 18, 1942**

The Conference opened at 9 A. M. by singing "It is Mine" led by O. E. Fields. Prayer by M. L. Peterson of Omaha, Neb.

Devotions consisted of Scripture quotations by Members of Conference.

Minutes of the last sitting read and approved.

The Resolution Committee gave the rest of their report which was accepted.

Brother Fenton from Aurora, Mo., was introduced to the Conference and by motion was granted an honorary seat in the Conference bar.

Ways and Means Committee reported and was accepted.

Auditing Committee gave their report which was accepted.

District Statistician reported and his report was accepted.

Examining and Educational Committee gave the rest of their report which was accepted.

Rev. R. A. Beltz reported as to the Incorporation of the Central District, the following: "After due investigation and obtaining legal advice it was found unnecessary and unadvisable to incorporate Central District."

District Superintendent made the appointments of Committees.

Invitations from the following Churches were given for the Christian Workers' Convention: Springfield, Missouri; Des Moines, Iowa; Omaha, Neb.; Eddyville, Iowa. The Conference recessed for five minutes after which the Ordination service followed with Rev. A. C. Wieand and Rev. Chester Whittington being ordained.

Rev. Edward Boone led the song "A Charge to Keep."

Scripture readings were read by the following: Rev. M. L. Peterson, Rev. H. H. Bolender and Rev. R. A. Beltz.

Prayer was offered by Rev. W. O. Bottenberg.

Rev. L. W. Sturk brought the Ordination Message.

The business of the Conference having been finished we were dismissed by prayer.

The District owns a set of the above books which will be loaned to those pursuing the Course of Study. A book will be loaned for 60 days without charge; if kept more than 60 days at one time a charge of 10 cents per week will be made. Each student taking an examination on any of the above books shall pay the respective examiner 50 cents per examination.

#### **REPORT OF THE RESOLUTION COMMITTEE AS ADOPTED BY THE CONFERENCE**

1. Be it resolved that each of our resolutions remain in effect from year to year except when revoked by the District Conference.

2. Be it resolved that when churches are changing pastors at the end of the Conference year, that the retiring pastor shall hold office to and including the last Sunday of the District Camp. The new pastor shall assume his responsibilities on the first Sunday following the Camp. The Church shall pay the pastor's salary while he is attending Camp.

3. Be it resolved that each pastor consult the District Superintendent before calling an evangelist.

4. Be it resolved that each church pay their offerings to deputational workers of the Bible School, Foreign Missions and Home Missions and Rescue Home through the District Treasurer, so that the District will receive credit for the same.

5. Be it resolved that each pastor be permitted to conduct two revival meetings away from his own charge during each Conference year, if it can be planned so as not to conflict with the local church work.

6. Since our Camp meeting is growing from year to year, and many items are needed, such as bedding and cooking utensils, we recommend that each church furnish as many of these items as possible before next Camp. The District Council shall make a list of things needed and the pastors shall present this list to the churches.

7. Be it resolved that the conference year close June 30th. All church and ministers' reports shall be sent immediately to the District Statistician so that they may be compiled before the Conference. The District Treasurer shall close his books on July 6th therefore, money must be mailed to the District Treasurer by July 1st to be included in the annual report. By action of the District Conference all churches who pay their District and General Budgets in full will be counted star Churches.

8. Be it resolved that the District Superintendent appoint all committees and a District Statistician. All the above appointments shall be announced at this Conference and their names printed in the Minutes.

9. Be it resolved that the District Council appoint a special committee to investigate the purchasing of a permanent camp ground, said committee to be composed of five members. This committee, with the Council, shall be authorized to purchase a ground, if after their investigation they find a suitable place.

10. Be it resolved that the District Council select the location and date for a Christian Workers' Convention after receiving invitations from the churches, and that we urge all ministers, Sunday School superintendents and young people's workers to attend.

11. Be it resolved that the District Council select a location and date for our Conference and Camp and call the evangelist and workers.

12. Be it resolved that we give a rising vote of thanks to the Arch St. Methodist Church for their kindness and liberal considera-

tions in regard to the use of their kitchen and dining room, and that a letter of thanks be sent them from this Conference.

13. Be it resolved we have a Sunday School rally as was provided in the Previous General Conference and two banners be provided by the District and given, one for gain in attendance above the previous quarter, the other given on largest percentage of gain over the previous quarter and that the interdenominational Sunday Schools in our district be included in this rally.

14. Be it resolved that we express our appreciation to the following for their labors in this Conference and Camp by a rising vote of thanks.

To Rev. W. O. Bottenberg, our District Superintendent, for his splendid work and untiring efforts this past year over the District.

To Rev. L. W. Sturk, our beloved Assistant General Superintendent, for the splendid efficient way in which he has conducted this Conference.

To all who worked and assisted in the kitchen and dining room.

To Rev. and Mrs. W. L. Smith, pastors of the Hannibal Church and their good people for their liberality and hospitality in entertaining the Camp and Conference.

To Rev. W. L. Smith, our secretary, and Rev. R. A. Beltz, our treasurer, for their faithful service and their efficient and accurate work.

To Mrs. W. O. Bottenberg and Sister Bradshaw and Sister Scrace in securing rooms and beds for the visitors and registration of the same.

To Rev. L. W. Sturk, our evangelist, who faithfully ministered God's Word, which was instructive and convicting and enjoyed by all.

To Rev. and Mrs. Gaylord, our foreign Missionary representatives, for the inspirational service given.

#### **REPORT OF WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE AS ADOPTED BY THE CONFERENCE**

These amounts shall begin with the month of July and shall be sent to the District Treasurer not later than the tenth of the following month.

3. Since the above amounts do not include the General Budget, (General Budget includes monies for Foreign Missions, General Home Missions and General Church administrative expense,) we recommend that each church raise their General Budget monthly, on the basis as set up by the General Conference and the General Board.

4. We recommend that the District Superintendent visit each church and preaching point three times a year; that he be allowed the privilege of holding four revival meetings off the District. The remainder of his time shall be devoted to District evangelism and home missionary work.

5. We recommend that the District Superintendent be paid a salary of \$125.00 a month, plus two cents a mile for traveling on the District in visiting churches and Home missionary work; that he be allowed expense for postage, phone calls and telegrams; that he be permitted to keep his evangelistic offerings over and above his salary, but he shall pay his own traveling expenses to and from same. At each visit of the District Superintendent the churches shall take an offering for him, the same to be applied on his traveling expense and the church shall be credited for this amount on their District Budget. The Superintendent shall send all such offerings to the District Treasurer, who shall receipt the churches for the same.

6. We recommend that the District Secretary publish 500 copies of the Minutes of this Conference. The Minutes shall be distributed among the churches and the pastors will distribute them among the members.

7. We recommend that there be a Camp and Conference registration fee of \$1.00 per person for those above 12 years of age and 50 cents per person for those between the ages of 5 and 12 years. All those who pay the registration fee will be given a meal ticket.

We further recommend that there shall be a small charge for beds, the rates to be fixed by the District Council and printed on the Camp Meeting advertising.

All those who register shall be expected to share in the work necessary for the maintenance of the camp and Conference.

The District Treasurer shall set aside \$20.00 a month from the District Budget fund for a special Camp and Conference fund toward the expenses of the Annual Camp and Conference.

8. We recommend that the District Treasurer be paid \$35 for his services during the year, and the District Secretary \$25.

9. We recommend that the District Treasurer be authorized to set aside \$75.00 each year during the next quadrannium for General Conference expense. This money shall be taken from the District Budget fund.

10. Inasmuch as Central District is a part of the zone of the Colorado Springs Bible Training School we recognize our responsibility to support this school, Therefore we recommend that the churches be apportioned the following monthly amounts for the Bible School:

## DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

TO THE SIXTH ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF THE CENTRAL DISTRICT OF THE PILGRIM HOLINESS CHURCH.

Greetings:

Another church year has become history. During this time our nation has become engaged in another great war. Our hearts are often heavy because of the blood-shed on so many battle fields. Soldiers are saying goodby to loved ones for the last time. God's people are engaged in a great war against sin and unrighteousness, but we are assured of certain victory if we will be good soldiers of Jesus Christ. We praise God for the advancements that have been made. Surely we have lots to be thankful for. Many of the churches have enjoyed good revivals, and our district shows a wonderful gain in finance.

One new church of nineteen members has been organized at Omaha, Nebraska, a church and parsonage has been purchased and remodeled, and this property is valued at over \$4,000.00. Rev. M. L. During the past year we attended one School Board meeting at Colorado Springs, one General Board meeting in Indianapolis, the General Conference at Owosso, spoke in interest of Sunday Schools at Joliet, Ill.; was the speaker in some special services in the Bible School; also enjoyed a very fine Christian Workers' Convention in

Des Moines, thus making the total of miles covered about 30,000.

Our salary from Central District is paid in full, amount received from revivals, \$350.00, making a total of \$1,450.00.

These are good days spiritually to my Soul, never loved the Lord better than right now. I appreciate the fine cooperation received over the district from our ministers and the churches. There are several very fine prospects for new Pilgrim churches in the near future. We love the Pilgrim church, and our General officers. The opportunity and responsibility of our church was never greater. Let us go forth in God's great harvest field, with a vision for the lost, for surely the coming of the Lord draweth nigh.
