**SECOND SESSION**

The second session of the Assembly opened at 9 o'clock a. m., July 9, 1931, with prayer and singing. Brother O. F. Gault read the scripture lesson.

Rubie Gault read the financial report covering the receipts and disbursements of the district treasury for the past conference year. Report Accepted.

**THIRD SESSION**

The third session of the annual district Assembly was called to order at 9 o'clock a. m., July 10, 1931. Sister Garner conducted the devotional service, reading the 5th chapter of I. Thes. Brother O. F. Gault led in prayer.

The chair appointed O. F. Gault to act as Secretary in the absence of Mrs. Satre.

**Letter of Recommendation**

A letter of recommendation from the Rocky Mountain District, recommending Brother George Doll to this district, was read.

Motion was made that he be accepted in this district, and his name be placed on the roll of licensed ministers. Motion Carried.

Brother L. W. Goss addressed the Assembly. Motion was made that he be accepted in this district, and his name be placed on the roll of Ordained Ministers. Motion Carried.

#### **Resignation**

Brother O. F. Gault resigned as member of the examining board due to leaving the district in the near future.

Sister Dorothea Calhoon was elected to finish Brother O. F. Gault's unexpired term.

#### **District Examining Board**

Sister Ida Garner was re-elected as a member of examining board.

The examining board now stands as follows: Ida Garner, 3 years; W. J. Webster, 2 years; Dorothea Calhoon, 1 year.

Motion made that the examining board act also as an educational board. Motion Carried.

#### **District Board of Trustees**

Brother J. S. Gault was elected as a member of trustee board.

The trustee board now stands as follows: J. S. Gault, 3 years; R. A. Fullerton, 2 years; W. J. Webster, 1 year.

#### **District Camp Meeting**

Motion was made that this district have a district camp meeting this coming year. Motion Carried.

#### **Camp Meeting Committee**

Motion made that the district superintendent appoint the camp meeting committee. Motion Carried.

#### **Committee**

The committee was appointed as follows: W. J. Webster, C. C. Calhoon, R. A. Fullerton, J. S. Gault, George Doll.

#### **District Camp Meeting**

Motion made that the district Assembly be held in connection with the district camp meeting. Motion Carried.

Motion made that Miss Hazel Goss be accepted in this district and that her name be placed on roll of licensed ministers.

Motion Carried.

#### **Athol Report**

The report of the Athol church was not available until after the Assembly, but the report is included in the statistical report.

The Assembly adjourned by singing the song, "Blest Be the Tie That Binds."

The presence of God was recognized in our midst and a sweet spirit of brotherly love and humility was manifested throughout the Assembly.

#### **Camp Meeting Committee**

Motion made that the district council determine where the camp meeting be held this coming year. Motion Carried.

Motion made that the camp meeting committee work in conjunction with the District Council in deciding date of the camp meeting and the District Assembly. Motion Carried.

### Other Reports

Report from Sister Lelia Scott was read. Motion made that her report be accepted. Carried.

### Resolutions Committee Report

Resolutions committee reported and the following resolutions were adopted by the Assembly.

#### Resolution No. 1:

Resolved, That each local church of the district be assessed to the minimum of \$3.00 per adult member to help finance the district expense fund and that one-half of said amount be paid in or on January 1, 1932.

#### Resolution No. 2:

Resolved, That a special service be held and a cash and pledge offering be taken for Home Missions during District Camp Meeting, and that each local church in the district hold a Home Missionary service and take a special offering at least twice during the conference year.

#### Resolution No. 3:

Resolved, That a copy of these resolutions be placed in the hands of each Pilgrim Holiness family and minister of this district.

#### Resolution No. 4:

Resolved that the District Superintendent make two visits annually to each local church unless conditions require more, and that a special offering be taken for him at the time of his visit.

#### Resolution No. 5:

Resolved, That \$100.00 be paid our District Superintendent from the district treasury. This amount to be paid in quarterly installments.

#### Resolution No. 6:

Resolved, That the District Superintendent should draw upon the district treasury for traveling expenses incurred in the interest of the district.

#### Resolution No. 7:

Resolved, That every member of the Assembly be requested to attend the Assembly sessions or furnish a legitimate excuse in writing.

#### Resolution No. 8:

Resolved, That the District Superintendent visit all independent churches and Missions of the district which are supplied by ministers who are members of this Assembly.

#### Resolution No. 9:

Resolved, That all monies or receipts for monies sent to the different departments of the general church be given to the local church treasurer and then forwarded to the District Treasurer in order that our financial records shall be complete.

**Resolution No. 10:**

Resolved, That our District Superintendent shall have supervision over the Home Missionary work of this district.

**Resolution No. 11:**

Resolved, That the district guarantee a home missionary evangelist \$50.00 per month and living, traveling and incidental expenses for whatever time he is actually engaged in home missionary work.

**Time of Session Extended**

Motion made that the present session be extended until all business be attended to. Motion Carried.

**Statistical Report**

Statistical committee report was called for. Motion made that the statistical report be referred to editor of the Assembly minutes and that the report be spread on the minutes. Motion Carried.
