## REPORT OF THE DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT

To the members of the 12th annual conference of the Louisiana District of the Pilgrim Holiness Church, to Reverend R. C. Hawkins, our chairman and General Secretary, to our laymen and friends I greet you in Christ's name.

This year has flown swiftly by and now takes its place as a part of the history of our district and our denomination. Whatever gains that have been made and victories won is due to the faithfulness of God and the hard work of consecrated pastors and laymen.

Following is a general report of the material progress of the district and a report of my personal activities and ministry.

## GENERAL:

BASTROP--is experiencing its best year of progress since its beginning. God is using the ministry of the Rodriguez's in a marked way. All visible signs point to a great year this year.

BATON ROUGE--has been reopened again. This church has weathered many storms and is open now only because of a handful of Pilgrims who refused to be driven off during the storm. Brother W. C. Bowman and John Bowman are serving as pastor and assistant.

BOGALUSA--The church and parsonage have received an extensive remodeling. The upstairs, which was little more than an open attic, has been completely finished into three bedrooms. The downstairs has been ceiled overhead and redecorated completely. The church has been remodeled on the inside. Brother and Sister Creech have done a fine job.

COLUMBIA--has paid off their loan to Headquarters and negotiated a local loan for a new parsonage, which is within a few days of completion. It is a three-bedroom, one and one-half bath brick veneer. This could not have been accomplished without the hard and faithful work of Brother Green.

LAKE CHARLES--has tiled the auditorium and narthex which has added much to the beauty of the sanctuary. The lawn has been filled and palms planted. The largest gains are reflected by this church.

PINEVILLE--with six of their youth in Bible School and other families away most of the year, has still shown small gains. They have been able to establish many that were added to the church last year.

OAKDALE--The Rathbuns are liquidating a debt that has lingered for several years. The spiritual tide is gratifying there and the people are working hard.

SIMMS--has redecorated the parsonage and money has already been raised to build rest rooms in the church.

ALEXANDRIA--is showing the largest loss in membership which is in no way a reflection of its ministry this past year. We have a wonderful people here and my faith in them causes me to anticipate a great year of recovery.

SHREVEPORT--has now completed their building and the church is far more lovely than one might have hoped for. The outside has been brick veneered, walks poured and the entrance completed on the front of the building. A celetex ceiling has been installed, the walls have been decorated and new pews are now being built. Our people have worked long and hard for this plant.

TIOGA--which got off to a good start last year is now little more than a preaching point. This is due largely to three of the families moving out of the community. Reverend Wingfield is supplying there and he is encouraged with the present outlook.

WEST MONROE--has had a hard year and shown losses, however, I can not but feel that here is a real field of service to God and our church. Let us join in prayer for our people there.

#### FINANCIAL:

All our pastors have paid their tithe faithfully into the district. Six of our churches have paid their budget in full. We have received more money into the district than any other year. But inflation and added responsibilities have more than absorbed the increase. This year's budget must be adjusted to meet increased responsibilities for this year. The Bible School needs our help. (We MUST send our youth there for training and bring them back for service in our own district.)

#### PERSONAL:

We have no new works to present to this conference. Lake Charles has been fully organized this past year and the council has approved the opening of a new work there. Shreveport affords us the greatest opportunity for a new work at this report. Area and community surveys have been made and we have a good nucleus waiting ready to go as soon as we get the right man. Lots have been bargained for in the interest of a long range program in Monroe. Already the property value has increased \$500.00 in market price.

## CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS

The first sitting of the twelfth annual conference of the Louisiana District of the Pilgrim Holiness Church convened at 9:00 a.m. June 17, 1960 in the Alexandria Church.

The conference was opened by singing "He Hideth My Soul". Rev. Raymond Kensell led in prayer after which Rev. R. C. Hawkins, General Secretary of Church Extension; the chairman of the conference, was introduced.

Rev. Hawkins read from Revelation Chapter 1 centering his remarks around "The Glorified Christ," as described in the scripture.

The first order of business was the roll call by the conference secretary.

The conference bar was designated to include the first four rows of seats across the front of the church.

Motion prevailed to end the first sitting at 12:00 noon and conference to reconvene at 1:00 p.m. Motion carried.

It was moved and seconded to receive Rev. and Mrs. A. P. Huffine into the conference by transfer from the Arizona conference. Motion carried and they were seated within the conference bar.

It was moved and seconded to receive Rev. S. V. Repogle pending his letter from the Alabama-Northwest Florida District. Motion carried and he was granted a seat within the conference bar.

The chairman called for the report from the Educational and Examining Board. The motion to receive the report carried and those receiving first year license were seated within the conference bar.

At this point the Reception Committee introduced to the conference Rev. Don Huckleba, pastor of Bethel Chapel in Shreveport, Louisiana. After a glorious testimony of two works of grace, it was moved and seconded to grant Brother Huckleba an honorary seat within the conference bar.

The District Superintendent read his report which was received with a hearty "Amen."

The auditing report was read and accepted.

The treasurer's report was read and accepted.

The Statistician's report was read and accepted.

The reception committee introduced Rev. and Mrs. S. A. Thomas and Dale Morrell. These are workers in our all Mexican work in Raymondville, Texas. Each gave a good testimony and were granted an honorary seat within the conference bar.

The District Sunday School Secretary read his report which was accepted.

The District Youth Leader's report was read and accepted.

The chairman of the resolutions committee gave its report which after certain corrections and rejections was adopted.

The Ways and Means Committee's report was read and after being fully discussed was adopted.

By expiration of time the conference adjourned for the noon meal.

The conference was reopened at 1:00 p.m. by singing "Amazing Grace", Brother Huckleba then led in prayer.

The first order of business of the afternoon sitting was the election of officers for the coming year.

The Chairman read the appointments passed upon by the General Board: District Superintendent, Rev. Arnold Peck; Secretary, Paul Sherwood; Treasurer, Raymond Kensell.

Those elected as advisory members to the District Council were Rev. C. B. Cox and Mr. B. F. Garlington. These and other officers elected appear on the page with the official directory.

The District Superintendent read the committee appointments for the coming year.

The business being concluded we were adjourned in prayer by Mr. Lee Hollingsworth.

## COMMITTEE REPORTS

## RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE REPORT

1. Resolved that three copies of all reports be made; the monthly reports to be mailed; one to the General Secretary of Church Extension, and one to the District Superintendent. The annual reports to be sent immediately at the close of the year to the District Statistician and District Superintendent. The third copies of the reports to be retained for local files.

2. Resolved that each preacher and deaconess send a copy of his or her report to the District Statistician not later than ten days after the conference year closes.

3. Resolved that each church give a pounding for the pastor the first Sunday of each month and that the church board appoint someone to take care of this matter.

4. In as much as there are two elected advisory members to the District Council; Be it resolved that one may be a lay member.

5. In as much as it seems to work a hardship on the district, therefore be it resolved that the district camp be changed to a three day conference, beginning on Wednesday and closing on Friday; Be it further resolved to provide for a youth camp separate from the District Conference, the same to begin on Monday night and close on Friday.

6. Whereas the Finance Committee functioned so efficiently in the camp of 1958; Be it resolved that the District Superintendent appoint another committee for the district conference the coming year.

7. Whereas it works a hardship on the churches for the pastors to be gone so long at one time, Be it resolved that the pastor's vacation consist of sixteen (16) days.

8. In as much as the General Board has rezoned our district as a part of the Central Pilgrim College School Zone, Be it resolved that the District Superintendent and one lay member serve as our representative on the school board during the coming year.

9. Whereas the District Superintendent is in closer relation with our ministers of the district and their ministerial standing than the Educational and Examining Board; Be it resolved that the District Superintendent be a standing member of the Educational and Examining Board.

10. Be it resolved that the entire camp fund be placed in a savings account to be used only at the discretion of the district conference.

11. Resolved that this conference adopt a group hospitalization plan to be paid for either by the pastor or by his church, to be worked out between the pastor and his church.

12. Resolved that there be a Mens Fellowship entitled "Men for Missions" comparable to the Ladies Missionary Society. The purpose for the same is to sponsor new projects.

#### WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE REPORT

1. We recommend that all monies from the local churches destined to the General Treasurer be sent to the District Treasurer, and sent not later than the tenth of each month.

2. We recommend that the district treasurer be paid \$5.00 per month for his services; also that each member of the district council be paid at the rate of five cents per mile when called to district council meetings and the district treasurer and secretary be supplied their stationery and postage for district work.

3. We recommend that the district secretary be paid \$25.00 a year for his services.

4. We recommend that our S. S. Promotional Secretary and Executive Youth Secretary attend the Worker's Conference held annually at Church Headquarters. Expense for same shall be taken from these separate departmental funds.

5. We recommend a S. S. fund be adopted by the following plan; (a) The first Sunday of August shall be known as "S.S. Dollar Day" in our churches, wherein adults shall be urged to give one dollar. (b) All Sunday School offerings received this first Sunday of August shall be sent no later than August 15th to the District Treasurer. This is to become a separate S. S. fund which shall further be used to promote district Sunday School work.

6. We recommend that a district youth budget be inaugurated according to the following plan; Each local youth society shall set aside 10% of its weekly offering to be paid monthly to the district youth treasurer, and that 75% of the zone rallies' offerings be sent to the same immediately following such rallies. This fund shall be used to promote district youth work.

7. We recommend that the district pay its portion of the District Superintendent's salary which is \$115.00 a month, also that we pay him 5¢ per mile travel expense, his postage, stationery, Telephone expense (as used in connection with his duties in district work) and utilities.

8. We recommend that all the churches pay 10% of regular church and Sunday School offerings, to be sent in by the 10th of every month, for district operations.

9. We recommend that the dime cards be used for raising the General budget and Bible School offerings.
