Moved and seconded that we adjourn at 11:45 A. M. Carried.

Hour fixed for election of Officers 2:00 P. M. Moved and seconded that the reports be given. Carried.

Report of Hitchins Church was given by Rev. Leonard Bowling, Pastor, and accepted.

Report of Albert Selbee, Evangelist, was read and accepted.

Report of Olive Hill church was read by Rev. R. W. Chatfield, Pastor, and accepted. Report of Ashland Heights Church was given by Rev. John Fleming, Pastor, and accepted.

Report of Rollie Poe, Evangelist, was read and accepted.

Report of Rockdale Church was read by Bro. Browning, Delegate, and accepted.

Report of Bro. W. B. Fugitt was given and accepted.

Report of Rev. C. M. Tomlin was given and accepted.

Report of Rev. J. C. Baynum, Evangelist, was read and accepted.

Report of Rev. Edward Oney, Missionary, was read and accepted.

Report of Barterville Church was given by Rev. H. C. Snapp, Pastor, and accepted.

Report of Rev. James Williams, Evangelist, was given and accepted.

Report of Maysville Church was read by Carrie B. Dryden, Delegate, and accepted.

Report of Tolesboro Church was read by Rev. Madge Savage, Pastor, and accepted.

Moved and seconded that we adjourn until 2:00 P. M. carried.

SECOND BUSINESS SESSION

Convention was called to order at 2.00 P. M. with Rev. Posey, Dist. Supt. in Chair, moved and seconded that reports be finished before election of Officers, carried.

Report of Rush Church was read by Mrs. Albert Selbee, Delegate, and accepted.

Reports of Rev. Bona Fleming and wife, Rev. Shank and wife, Rev. John McMurlin, Rev. William Stapleton were read by Secretary and accepted.

Report of Rev. Warren Posey, District Supt., was given and accepted.

District Supt., explained to Convention that Rev. C. M. Tomlins' and Rev. H. C. Snapps' names who were under the Licenses Preachers in manual, was a mistake and ought to have been under the Ordained ministers.

Next in order, were The Election of Officers.

Moved and seconded that if Rev. R. W. Chatfield was elected as assistant Supt. he could hold the office providing he was capable of being ordained.

—Carried.

Moved and seconded that we have no nominations for office,—Carried.

Moved and supported that Secret Ballot be cast and the majority of Votes elects to office-carried.

Supt. appointed Rev. Edward Oney and Rev. R. W. Chatfield as Tellers.

As a result of Ballots cast the following officers were elected.

Committee on Licenses reported and Rev. Fugitt, Browning, Garvin, and Bourgaize were granted licenses to Preach.

Adjourned 4:30 P. M.

THIRD BUSINESS SESSION

Convention was called to order by Supt. at 9:00 A. M.

Opened by singing and prayer.

Supt. read rules and regulations of our ministers.

Moved and approved that the Advisory Board names be signed to a letter written by Supt. requesting all Preachers to report every quarter, and if failed to do so, after they are written, the Supt. shall drop their credentials.

Moved and approved that Delegates that were late give their reports.

Report of Tolesboro Church was read by Bro. Garvin, Delegate, and accepted.

Report of Vanceburg Church was read by Mrs.

Marshall Bertram, Delegate, and accepted. Next in order, was The Support of the District work.

Moved and seconded that the Preachers pay \$6.00 per year into the Treasury and pay every quarter, Carried.

Moved and second that the churches be taxed for the District work—voted down.

Moved and second that the Churches make up a free will offering for Supt. when he visits the Churches.—Carried.

Next in order,—Ordination service and the following Ministers were ordained:

God's special anointings were upon this service.

Moved and seconded that the Pastor in connection with his Sunday School take a free-will offering every month for Foreign Missions,—Carried.

It was suggested that all missionary money given by our members be paid thru the church of which they are a member.

Rev. Edward Oney, 1810 Young St., Cincinnati, O., Missionary to Japan is recommended to our churches for* Missionary meetings.

REPORTS

Rev. Leonard Bowling, Pastor of Hitchins church. I preach two Sundays out of each month at Hitchins. We have had one tent meeting. 55 saved or sanctified. We have 17 members and the spiritual condition of the church is good. Have given and pledged to Foreign Missions \$87.00 Recd. for my labor \$150.00.

We are building a new church building. I also preach at Brammar Gap, Webbville, and Wolf Creek, Ky.

Rev. Albert Selbee, Evangelist:—

I have held 12 revivals—Preached 147 times, 426 knelt at the altar; 283 professions, Sold \$72.50 worth of Holiness Literature. Amount of offerings \$250.00. Have tithed and given to God. \$33.55.

Rev. R. W. Chatfield, Pastor at Olive Hill, Preached 126 sermons: made thirty Pastoral calls. Several professions. Total amount recd, for preaching. \$277.53. My church has 36 members and spiritual condition of church is good. Held three revivals.

Rev. John Fleming, Pastor at Ashland Heights 200 souls knelt at altar. Have a membership of 120. Held two meetings out side of charge. Recd. about \$1000.00 for work. Spiritual condition of church is excellent.

Rev. Rollie Poe Student at God's Bible School I have been in school the most of the year. I have helped in 5 revivals, preached 40 times and visited hundreds of homes. Collection \$23.13.

Bro. Browning,—Delegate from Rockdale church. We have a membership of 16. One revival held. Had 13 saved. We have no church building but planning to build this coming year.

Paid Evangelist \$110.00, Foreign Missions \$15.22. Home Missions \$171.01. Total \$296.23.

Bro. Tugett: Held 3 revivals at Frankfort, Stamp- ing Ground and Long Lake, Ky. Assisted by Bro. Browning.

Rev. C. M. Tomlin,—Have been sick and not preached very much. Helped in a few revivals and filed appointments for others.

Rev. J. C. Baynum, Evangelist,—Held 5 revivals preached 71 times, Conversions 103. Sanctifica- tions several.

Rev. Edward Oney, Missionary. Held Missionary meetings in the following places viz. Wilmore, Smoky Valley, Maysville, Vanceburg, Ashland, Hit- chins and Busseyville, Ky. Union City, Ind. Mains- ville, Rolls Hill, Huntington, Coxes Landng and

Ft. Gay, W. Va., Dayton, Athens, Springfield, and Dunkirk, Ohio. Cash and pledges \$1055.09 Preached 7 times. My offerings \$153.00.

Rev. H. C. Snapp, Pastor at Barterville:—

The church is not what it ought to be 17 members. Have charge of a mission at Cynthiana and it is prospering. Have had good missionary offerings. Rev. Chas. Slater held one revival.

Rev. James Williams, Have been in Bible school also have been working in mission work. God has given souls. Preach anywhere I have a chance.

Rev. C. C. Gilbert have not been out in the work much. Held one revivals. 16 professions. Also preached at three points.

Carrie B. Dryden, Delegate of Maysville church. Paid Evangelists \$110.00 Pastor \$260.00 Professions about 100. Members 53 Expelled 32 and church prospering.

Madge Savage, Pastor at Tolesboro. Church at present is not in a very good condition. But will soon be on a solid foundation and expect to prosper more the coming year. I preach there once a month and help in revivals other places and preach at other points viz: Enon, O., one Sunday at Vanceburg.

Mrs. Albert Selbee, Delegate from Rush, can only give Sunday School report. The School is good. Number of teachers 5. Average attendance 20 S. S. offerings \$47.13.

Rev. Garvin, Delegate from Tolesboro gave brief report of the work.

Mrs. Marshall Bertrams from Vanceburg gave the needs of their church. The important need was a Pastor to stay among them.

Report of District Supt. Rev. Warren Posey have been Pastor at Maysville and haven't had much opportunity to do much in District work. Preached about 240 Sermons: made 240 pastoral calls received about \$500.00.

Expect to give all my time to The District work.

Being next in order, the writer reports were read by the Secretary.

Rev. Wm. Stapleton Assistant Pastor, Ashland Heights, Have held prayer meetings once a week. Not many saved but saints edified. Have preached some at Ashland Heights and have seen many seek and find the Lord.

Rev. John McNurlin have preached at the different places viz., Ashland Heights, Fairview, Rush, and Coal Grove. Have worked in prayer meetings, healing services and etc., Believe I have been used of the Lord in the salvation of Souls.

Bona Fleming and Wife, Evangelists have held revivals at the following places viz., Fairview, Bruin, Jetty, Jackson, Somky Valley, Cynthiana, Blue Lick Springs, and Rockdale, Ky. Grand Valley and Cobbs Corners, Pa., Cincinnati, Harriet and Dunkirk, O. Bennington and East Enterprise, Ind. Helped in the following places. Willard, Ashland Heights and Pike St., Mission, Covington, Ky. One of our revivals continued eight weeks and several continued over three Sundays. About 726 souls have knelt at the altar.

R. A. Shank and Wife, Song Evangelist:—

We have assisted as Song Evangelists in the following places, viz: Bruin, Barberville, Cynthiana and Rockdale, Ky. Huntington, W. Va. Oak Hill, Chillicothe, Portsmouth, Mt. Sterling, Cincinnati and Springfield, O. Northville, Tacoma Park, and Houghton, S. Dak.

By request of Mrs. R. A. Shank, her credentials will not be renewed. For the reason, she says she don't feel called to preach.

Rev. Dillard Fortner:—I have preached once a week at Lovland, O. Prayer meeting twice a week, the church was in a bad condition when we came but quite a change now.

Rev. Harvey Kelly preached about 50 times held

4 revivals. Helped in other meetings. The Lord is blessing.

M. N. Picklesimer, Pastor at Vanceburg, Preached 95 times. Prayer meetings 50. Held 2 meetings, Assisted in three. Total at altar 55. 26 saved, 2 sanctified. Superintendent of S. S., Preach at Firebrick, Martin and Coal Grove..

Taken nine into church, expelled five, one death. Baptized one. Performed 10. Marriage Ceremonies. Membership of church 18. Out of debt. Amount in offerings \$50.00.

Rev. G. V. Bevington, held 420 prayer meetings; made 780 calls; prayed in 670 homes; distributed 32,000 tracts. 27 cases of healing, have walked 1200 miles, have prayed 1825 hours, held 4 revivals and kept the Devil on the guessing.
