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## Minutes of the Twenty-Second Annual Conference of the Oklahoma and Texas District

First sitting of the Conference convened at Hopeton, Okla., July 26, 1948, at 9:00 A. M. General Superintendent, Rev. L. W. Sturk, presiding.

Rev. David Hall led the Conference in singing "He Abides" and "Power in the Blood." Rev. J. R. Kelly led in prayer.

Rev. Sturk addressed the Conference, using for a subject, Foreward; Reading from Exodus: 14.

The District Secretary gave the roll call.

Motion prevailed that the first four rows of seats on the North and South, and the first five rows of seats in the center constitute the conference bar.

Motion prevailed the Conference time be set as follows: From 9:00 A. M. until 11:45 A. M., and from 1:00 until 5:00 P. M. and from 7:00 P. M. until finished.

Report of the Examining Board was read and accepted.

Rev. Paul C. Nering was received into the District from the Rocky Mountain District.

M. G. Nelson and E. V. League were appointed to the Reception Committee.

The Reception Committee introduced Guy C. Jones, Sister Clark, David Hall, Paul C. Nering, J. B. Zeits, Fred Atkinson and Brother Thomas, of Bethany, to the Conference.

The report of Rev. D. R. Close, District Superintendent, was given and received.

Conference recessed for five minutes, to be called to order by Brother Sturk.

Report of the Resolutions Committee was read and accepted as printed in the reports.

Conference adjourned by expiration of time.

Conference re-convened with the singing of "Such Love." Rev. Paul Nering led in prayer.

Rev. L. W. Sturk gave a short address on the subject of Unity.

The report of the Statistical Committee was read and accepted.

The report of the Ways and Means Committee was read and accepted as printed in the Minutes.

Motion prevailed that Walter Quinn be seated as delegate from Devine.

After a season of prayer to God for Devine guidance in the election, led by Brother Sturk, the election was the order of the day.

Rev. D. R. Close was elected as District Superintendent. Rev. Paul C. Nering as Assistant Superintendent.

Rev. J. F. Wilson was elected as District Secretary.

Rev. E. C. Gafford was elected as District Treasurer.

W. P. Haltom, M. G. Nelson and E. V. League were elected as Advisory members of the Council.

Rev. E. V. League was elected to a three-year term on the Educational Board.

W. P. Haltom was elected to the Bible School Board.

Rev. Paul C. Nering was elected to the Examining Board.

Charles Nelson was elected as a member of the District Trustees.

The report of the District Treasurer was given and accepted.

There being no further business, Conference adjourned.

1. We recommend that each church be budgeted as follows:

2. We recommend that the District Superintendent be paid 4 cents per mile travel expense.

3. We recommend that all ministerial tithe be paid to the District Treasurer monthly, this money to be placed in the district fund.

4. We recommend that the birthday offering of the Sunday Schools be given in interest of the Bible School.

5. We recommend that the registration fee for the camp be set as follows: \$2.25 for adults who stay the full time; \$1.25 for those who come on or after the last Thursday. Children 5 to 12 one-half adult fee.

6. We recommend that the District Treasurer be paid a salary of \$50.

7. We recommend that the District Secretary be paid a salary of \$30.

8. We recommend that the district postage, stationery, telegrams, and telephone calls be out of the district budget.

9. We recommend that all district and general funds be forwarded to the District Treasurer the first of each month.

10. We recommend that all district checks from the banks be kept on file and be turned over with the treasurer's books.

11. We recommend that the District Superintendent be paid a salary of \$25 a week.

12. We recommend that the District Home Missionary offering, which is taken the last Sunday of the camp, be applied in the interest of District Home Missions, and the distribution of all home missionary money shall be left to the District Council.

13. We recommend that we have 200 copies of the Minutes of the 1948 conference printed and that we sell them at 10 cents per copy.

## Recommendations of the Resolutions Committee

### STANDING RESOLUTIONS

1. We recommend that the fiscal year close June 30th.
2. Inasmuch as the District Treasurer has so much work to do at the close of the year, be it resolved that all district and general monies be sent to the District Treasurer not later than July 10th.
3. Be it resolved that all delegates exceed the age of eighteen years.
4. Be it resolved that the Council make arrangements for a quarterly bulletin of district interests to be sent to each church.
5. Whereas it is so expensive to buy new tents and we must conserve the one we have, be it resolved that each time the tent is used for established churches the sum of \$5.00 be sent to the district treasurer, and that \$15.00 be paid for the use during District Camp; also that each Sunday School with an attendance of over 50 pay 20c per week and the schools with an attendance of under 50 pay 10c per week into the tent fund.
6. In order that we may conserve the Lord's money and give our churches the advantage of evangelistic meetings, be it resolved that we as pastors and churches consult our Superintendent in slating Evangelists and, if it is possible and practical, that they be slated for two or more consecutive meetings which would keep down traveling expense.
7. Inasmuch as there is a great blessing derived from a ministerial and Christian workers convention, be it resolved that during the year we have a three-day convention in the district to be divided between the Ministerial and Sunday School Convention. The council shall be the committee to set the time and prepare the program.
8. We recommend that the District Superintendent appoint all committees for the next year during the present conference sitting.
9. Be it resolved that our camp begin the third Friday in July.
10. Whereas it is quite a job to get ready for camp and to clean up after the camp and as camp comes in a busy time, be it resolved that each minister come a day earlier and stay throughout the camp and a day after camp unless excused by the District Council. If it is impossible to come, unless excused, be it resolved that he send the sum of \$5.00 to help on camp meeting expense or to hire labor in erecting and dismantling the camp equipment whichever the council deems needful.
11. Be it resolved that each pastor have the privilege of conducting two revival meetings off charge during the year; providing that his or her charge be supplied satisfactorily with the local church board.
12. Resolved that the camp have children and young people services, the District Council to secure a leader for each and said meetings to be announced on the camp meeting bills.
13. Resolved that the District Council set the date for the District Conference.
14. Resolved that each active minister be released for two Sundays during the camp and conference and that they receive regular salary or offering, providing they attend Camp and Conference.
15. Resolved that the first prayer meeting night in each month shall be donation night for the pastors of the district. The announcement shall be made the Sunday previous by someone appointed by the local church board.
16. Be it resolved that the pastors be required to see that all reports are mailed to the District Superintendent by the 15th of the month following the close of the quarter, and that the annual reports be mailed to the chairman of the Statistical Committee by July 15th.

17. Be it resolved that the District remain divided into zones as follows: Zone 1, Hopeton, Pleasant View and Fairview; Zone 2, Pond Creek, Blackwell, Newkirk and Enid; Zone 3, Henryetta, Oklahoma City and Bethany; Zone 4, Devine and Hillsboro.

18. Be it further resolved, that the pastors of each zone constitute the committee to prepare the program for the rallies in their respective zones.

19. We further recommend that when practical and possible, one rally be conducted in each zone during the year, and that all rallies shall be under the supervision of the District Superintendent.

### NEW RESOLUTIONS

1. Resolved that we have a workers meeting in the 1949 camp meeting beginning at 9:30 a. m. to 10:15.

### SPECIAL RESOLUTIONS

1. Be it resolved that we, the District Conference, express our appreciation to our District Superintendent, Rev. D. R. Close for his labors of love among us the past year by a rising vote of thanks.

2. Be it resolved that we, the District Conference, express our appreciation to Brother Sturk for his labors among us during the camp and conference.

3. Be it resolved that we, the District Conference, express our appreciation to the cooks and all those who so faithfully and willingly provided entertainment during this camp and conference by a rising vote of thanks.

4. We are indeed grateful for God's blessings and presence and Thank Him for the gracious victories and golden opportunities which this camp meeting has brought to everyone. Truly we can say God has done great things for us whereof we are glad. Praise His Name!
