Basic Requirements to Becoming a Military Chaplain

- · Age requirement: less than 36 years old
- Good physical health and conditioning
- · U.S. Citizenship preferred
- Ordained Minister with the Wesleyan Church
- Education of 70+ Graduate Theological Semester Hours
- Typically a Master of Divinity Degree or equivalent
- From an accredited institution by Assoc. of Theological Schools
- Two Years of Full-time ministry after educational degree

- · District Endorsement
- Military Service Acceptance
- Denominational Endorsing Committee (May –Nov)
- · Military Accession Board
- · Expect a 6-Month Decision Process
